

Trails Grant Submission to Lodging Tax Advisory Council

PLVC-Trails submitted an Activity Grant request to LTAC for 2022, funding 2023. This activity grant consists of three actions that support tourism in Port Ludlow:


- 1. Producing Updated Trail Maps: \$1833.02
- 2. <u>Producing and installing ten interpretive signs and six benches on</u> the new McCormick Rail Trail: \$2519.44
- 3. Producing and installing interpretive structures (two signs, fence, gate and memorial) at the Historic Port Ludlow Cemetery: \$3883.12

Total Amount Requested: \$8235.58

Received approval from LMC to construct the proposed Oak Bay Trail First proposed @ 2011

November 2022

- Began to finalize adjusted route for historic McCormick Rail Trail and connecting McCormick Loop Trail
- McCormick Rail Trail to connect to Interpretive Trail
- McCormick Loop Trail to connect to Timberton Homes Trail



December 2022

- Reflagged McCormick Loop routes
- Felled leaning & dead alder trees over and adjacent to the ABT Trail near Ludlow Cove
- Pioneered & flagged new route for Mt. Wilder/DNR connector
- Cleared downed trees on Olympic Terrace Loop
- Repaired deteriorating old bench on Timberton Loop Trail

February 2023 Repaired benches on Picnic Point with added anchorages for hold downs







March 2023 Repurposed Interpretive Trail directional sign








